All guests must wear a face mask inside the restaurant, unless eating or drinking at their table. Chez Gilles Fine Dining & Catering will provide guests with a complimentary mask if necessary.

- All employees undergo health checks before entering the restaurant. If they present signs of illness they will not enter the building.
- Masks are worn by employees within the restaurant and all employees follow strict hygiene routines at all times (hand washing or sanitizing after serving and clearing, before preparing drinks etc.) Eye protection may be worn by staff when within 2 metres of non-mask wearing guests.
- Only designated staff have access to the kitchen pass and are permitted to deliver food to guests.
- Tables and chairs have been removed to ensure a 2 metre distance between seated guests. Restaurant guest capacity for indoor dining is 24
- Guests seated together should be from the same household.
- All guests are asked to maintain physical distancing (2 metres apart).
- Hand sanitizer is provided to all guests upon arrival and all guests visiting our restaurant will be required to use hand sanitizer prior to entering and when leaving.
- Full contact tracing and health/exposure checks are conducted with all guests
- All surfaces within the restaurant are sanitized thoroughly (including payment processing pinpads) at frequent intervals, and between each use.
- Washrooms are checked and sanitized regularly.
- Sanitized, wipeable menus (or single use) are provided or if guests prefer, they can view our entire menu online at chezgillesmeaford.ca or by using our QR code
- Our service procedures have been adjusted to minimize contact at the table.

Covid Screening Questions

1. Do you have any of the following new or worsening symptoms or signs? Symptoms should not be chronic or related to other known causes or conditions.

Fever or chills, Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath, Cough, Sore throat, trouble swallowing, Runny nose/stuffy nose or nasal congestion, Decrease or loss of smell or taste, Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, Not feeling well, extreme tiredness, sore muscles

2. Have you travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days?

3. Have you had close contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19?

If the individual answers **NO** to all questions from 1 through 3, they have passed and can enter the restaurant.
